Western Oklahoma State College is excited to announce the newest addition to campus, the Veteran's Lounge, honoring active and/or reserved service members and veterans. The lounge is located in A-20 and will be open Monday-Friday from 8:30 A.M.- 3:00 P.M.

Spring of 2019, several Western employees attended the Oklahoma Military-Connected Student Success Conference at the Oklahoma of University. During the event, they listened to veteran speakers and visited OU's veteran's lounge. "This sparked an interest to have a place on Western's campus to help veterans feel at ease and a sense of belonging, said Terri Pearson, vice president of Student Support Services. Under Pearson's leadership and a team made up of two veterans on campus, Bruce Wilson, assistant director of WINDS and Kenny Mendez-Diaz, director of Upward Bound, the brainstorming and planning began.
