Western Oklahoma State College waives ACT/SAT Admission Requirements

Altus, OK. –The effects of the Covid-19 pandemic have created many obstacles over the last 9 months; however, one large obstacle is the limitations for ACT/SAT testing. Western is excited to announce, due to these limitations the ACT/SAT requirements for first-year applicants will be waived, for those who meet requirements.

"We are so pleased schools are being allowed to take this step to eliminate one of the many hurdles the students have faced since the beginning of COVID," said Lana Scott, director of admissions & registrar. "We feel the students have enough struggles and barriers navigating college without worrying about how they are going to sit for the ACT/SAT."

When applying for admission, students will have the option to apply without a test score, indicating they were unable to take the ACT or SAT due to Covid-19. Students can then apply with only a high school transcript and will be required to take placement tests through the testing center.
