Upward Bound hosts Senior Night

The Western Oklahoma State College Upward Bound team celebrated their high school seniors at their annual Senior/Parent Night on October 10.

Western's Upward Bound program is a dynamic college-based program for high school student who attend Altus, Hollis, Olustee-Eldorado, Snyder, and Tipton. Upward Bound students come from families with limited financial resources and/or have parents who have not received a bachelor's degree. Upward Bound is a TRIO Program, federally funded by the United States Department of Education.

Each year, the program hosts a Senior/Parent Night to celebrate the high school seniors that have gone through the program. Eighteen students were honored at the event, including eight from Altus, six from Hollis, three from Olustee-Eldorado, and one student from Snyder.

"The evening is special for the students and all of us at Western," said Kenneth Mendez-Diaz, Western Upward Bound Director. "This year's students were the first I had the chance to recruit, which made it even more special for me. It's incredible to watch them



grow and learn over the years."

The night includes a financial aid workshop, information regarding the FAFSA application, and speakers from various departments on campus.

"This evening is about the seniors and helping them gain all of the tools necessary to be successful and continue their education at Western," Mendez-Diaz said.

Western's Upward Bound program provides various opportunities to experience academic programs, cultural events, and other activities not usually available to first generation students or students from families with limited financial resources. Information, activities and instruction are designed to acquaint youth with a range of career options and career job shadow with area professionals. The services and opportunities are provided at no cost to students or families.


