## **OKLAHOMA STATE REGENTS ACADEMIC SCHOLARS PROGRAM SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION**

### **APPLICATION DEADLINE: March 1, 2022**

For consideration, an applicant must meet at least one minimum criteria option listed below to be eligible to apply:

- Current GPA/Class Rank – Student must rank in the top 5% of their graduating class (or are Valedictorian or Salutatorian) and have a GPA of at least 3.7  
or
- Current ACT – Student must have an ACT composite score of at least a 29  
or
- GPA and ACT – Student must have an ACT composite score of at least a 26 **and** a 3.7 GPA

The Oklahoma State Regents Academic Scholars Scholarship is transferable to an approved Oklahoma college of the student's choice upon completion of their associate's degree or 48 credit hours at Western.

Students **MUST** maintain a 3.25 GPA and complete at least 24 credit hours per year to retain the scholarship. Nominated Western students will receive a full tuition waiver, a \$1,000 per year (\$500 a semester) fee waiver from the WOSC Foundation, Inc. and an additional \$2,200 cash award per year (\$1,100 per semester) from Oklahoma State Regents office.
